You can count on me.

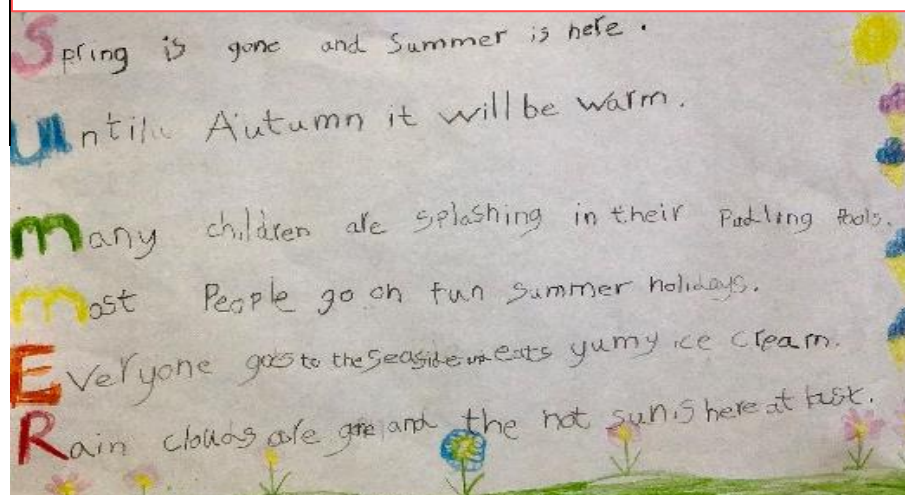

### VERY CHOCOLATEY CHOCOLATE FUDGE CAKE

#### Ingredients

- self-raising flour 150g
- cocoa 30g
- baking powder 1 tsp
- muscovado sugar 175g
- butter 175g, softened
- eggs 3
- vanilla extract 1 tsp
- dark chocolate 50g, melted



#### FUDGE ICING

- butter 200g, softened
- icing sugar 200g
- dark chocolate 200g, melted

#### Method

- **STEP 1** Heat the oven to 180C/fan 170C/gas 4. Line and butter 2 x 20cm sandwich tins.
- **STEP 2** Put all cake ingredients into the food processor and whizz until smooth. If the mix is a little stiff, add 1-2 tbsp water and whizz again.
- **STEP 3** Divide between tins, level and bake for 20 mins or until springy. Leave for 5 mins then cool on a rack.
- **STEP 4** Clean the food processor. Whizz the butter and icing sugar, add the chocolate, whizz again, then sandwich and ice the cake.
