Health & Safety in and around the school grounds

- I would like to take this opportunity to remind parents about the importance of safety when dropping children off to school. In the interests of the children's safety, may I remind you <u>not</u> to park on the footpaths on Windsor Ave and Derryvolgie Ave, to leave the entrances to the school clear and to observe the "No Parking" yellow lines. These are now legally enforceable and tickets will be issued by police and wardens. The times of the restricted parking are on display on the road signs. Parents have informed me that it is becoming increasingly difficult for parents with push chairs, especially double buggies, to walk safely along the footpath when parents pull on to the kerb, so I would ask you to bear this in mind. At busy times I would ask parents to be patient.
- Parents are asked <u>not</u> to use the staff car parks for parking or access or to park in spaces at the front of the Barnardos offices along Windsor Avenue or in Ceara Court.
- Children should enter the premises through the pedestrian gates and **not the staff car parks** and use the Patrolman at all times. If any pupil needs to leave the school during the normal school day, for medical or other reasons, parents are asked to send a note to the class teacher and have the child collected <u>from the classroom</u> by a responsible adult. No child may leave school without these procedures being followed.
